

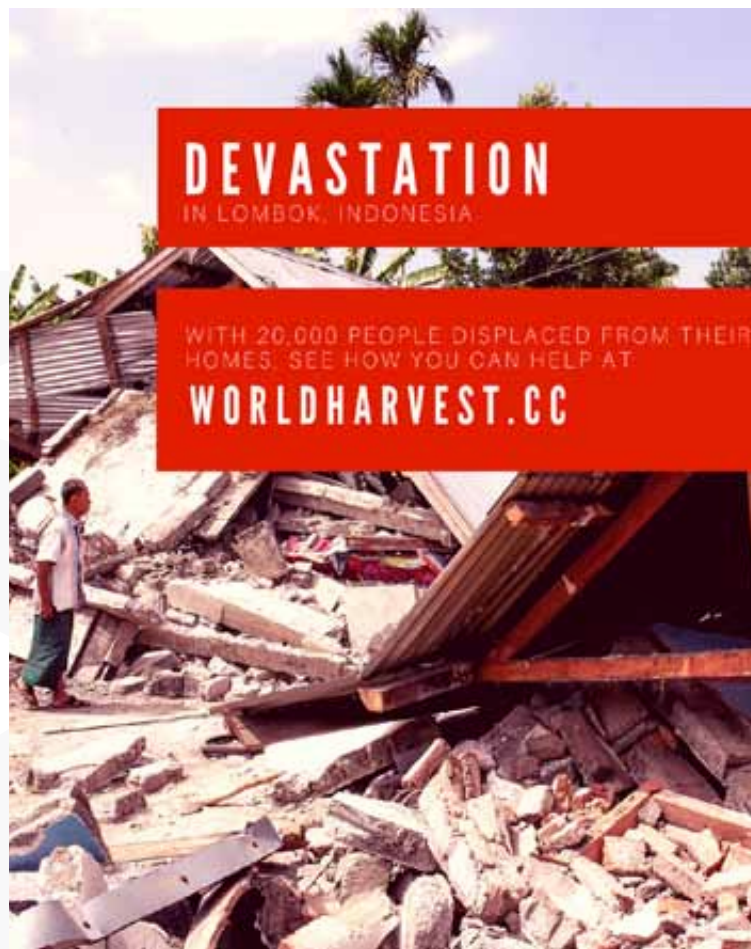


Devastation in Lombok, Indonesia

Since the beginning of August Lombok, Indonesia has suffered through countless devastating earthquakes. Indonesia straddles the Pacific “Ring of Fire” which is prone to earthquakes and volcanic eruptions with the most recent earthquakes averaging at magnitudes of 6.4. Over 400 people have been reported dead or missing while 20,000 have been displaced from their homes. With multiple reports of aftershocks, those numbers continue to rapidly rise.

WorldHarvest has been actively campaigning to help those who are displaced and surviving the earthquakes. We have currently acquired more than 2,000 pairs of shoes and sandals, clothing, bottled waters, tents, water purifiers, generators, rice, cooking oil, snacks, milk, cereal, and diapers for babies and children. Those supplies have been distributed to more than 1,500 families (over 6000 people including children) in more than 12 locations/camps.

Fairgrove Backpack Distribution

Fairgrove Academy is a K-8th public school located in La Puente, California. They were the recent recipients of our backpacks from our Buy One, Give One backpack campaign. We believe in creating an equal opportunity for students globally and our students in our own backyard to break the cycle of poverty. So, on August 17th, we are happy to report that we were able to distribute over 300 backpacks to the students from 6th-8th grade at Fairgrove Academy.

During the event we sold 20 backpacks from our Buy One, Give One backpack campaign. We are so grateful and thankful to those who came out and supported our booth during this event, your dedication to our mission to change the world through education makes all the

difference to the children.



The average median household income in La Puente is less than most of the surrounding areas here in California. Families of 4 or more are living in a home with an annual income of \$20,000 or less. Fairgrove Academy is a school that was created to give a higher level of education to an area with families that cannot otherwise afford a more well-rounded education. They are a school that is determined to break the cycle of poverty despite the fact that their average poverty level is two times higher than average from surrounding areas. La Puente has an average of 17.4% of households living under the poverty level, whereas Monrovia has 7% living below the national poverty level.

WorldHarvest with partners like Bazic Products, Team NuVision (Rudy L. Kusuma Home Selling Team) and Jans Enterprises Corp set out to distribute our Buy One, Give One campaign backpacks to this school in hopes to help relieve the stress of buying school supplies for the upcoming school year. We still have our sights set on even more communities in our surrounding areas and globally in the future, but it takes partners and remarkable individuals to

create a positive change. On behalf of the staff at WorldHarvest, we want to thank those who have purchased a backpack and our partners for making our backpack distribution at Fairgrove a success!

Summer Mission 2018

This past July, WorldHarvest visited Bali, Indonesia in hopes to carry out our mission of education & good will. Bali has one of the highest populations of drug addicts in Indonesia (61,353) and is

a hub for drug trafficking. It's also ranked 3rd nationwide for the highest number of reported HIV/AIDS cases (17,090 cases reported).



We sent out a team to educate nearly 2,000 students about all the negative side effects of drug abuse and the benefits of abstinence. Through this seminar WorldHarvest hopes to lower the number of reported HIV/AIDS cases and significantly reduce the high frequency of drug trafficking.

WorldHarvest also conducted free medical camps with the help of our partners Team NuVision – “Rudy L. Kusuma Home Selling Team”. Within the free medical camps, we were able to provide check-ups, medication, and medical advice for patients. Our team executed a total of **seven** camps within the two-week period in Bali, Indonesia where over **800** patients received quality health care in areas that are poverty-stricken.

WorldHarvest believes in giving opportunities to break the cycle of poverty and even though our focus is on the children’s education, we offer so much to our many communities. We chose Bali, Indonesia because we saw a great need there and we know that our work has only just begun.

We can only achieve it through the generous donations of our partners and donors. Thank you for your endless support in helping WorldHarvest accomplish its mission to serve Bali. Sewing School Graduation in Rwanda



In the beginning of 2018, WorldHarvest had a vision for helping drop-out students to develop skills to support themselves in Rwanda. For the past six months, with the help of our community leaders Mr. Makombe and his wife Sylvia, fourteen students have been attending our WorldHarvest vocational sewing school.

In Rwanda, it is very common for students between the ages of 17 and 25 years old to drop out of school because lack of finances or other family reasons. The vision with this vocational school offers students a chance to study business related courses in hopes of helping them design and start their own business.

Through your donations, WorldHarvest is happy to report that fourteen out of fourteen students have recently graduated our program. Within our program, our students learned the simple mechanical techniques for sewing, drawing and designing their own fashion, creating various types of clothing and how they can start their own business in their own community.

We couldn't have done it without the support of our donors, like yourself! We hope to partner with you in the future for even more programs similar to our sewing school in Rwanda. With your help, we can end the cycle of poverty and create sustainable economic growth globally!
